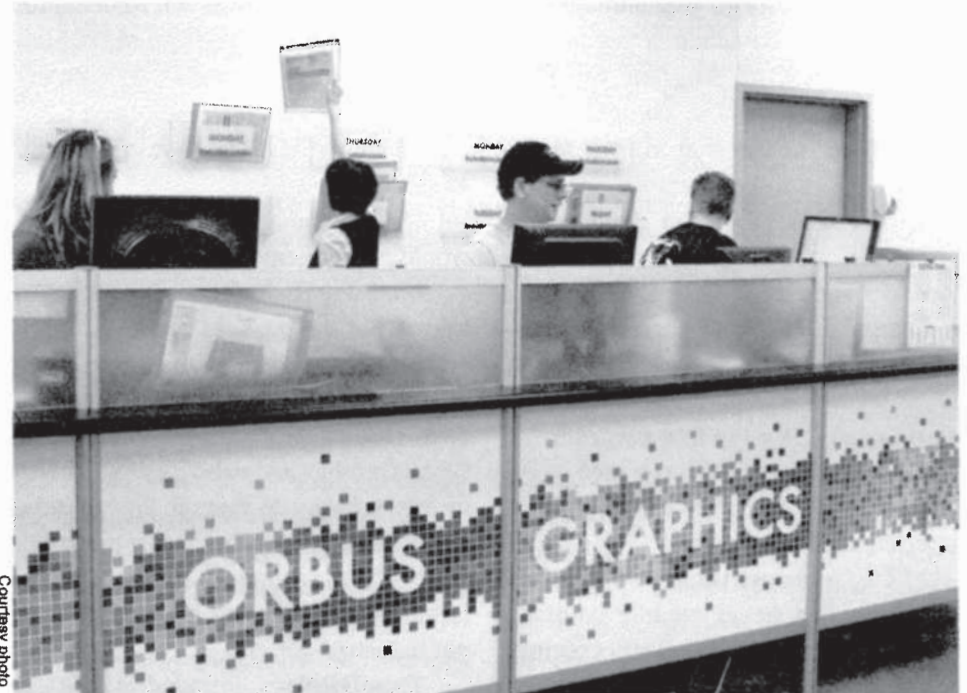
The Orbus Exhibit and Display Group is one of the first portable modular tradeshow manufacturers and suppliers in North America to achieve such certification.
